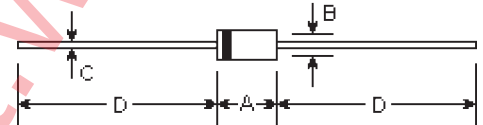

250°C/10 seconds, 0.375" (9.5mm) lead length,
5 lbs. (2.3Kg) tension

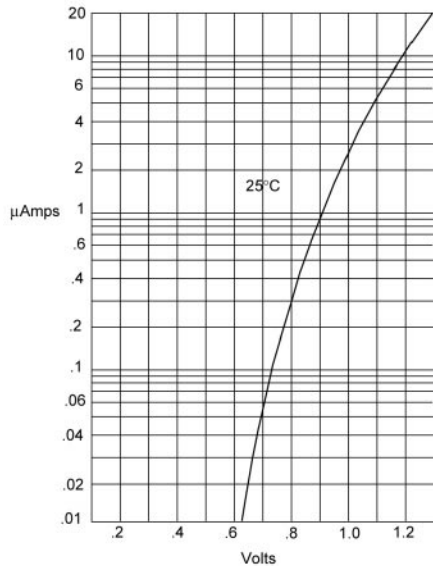

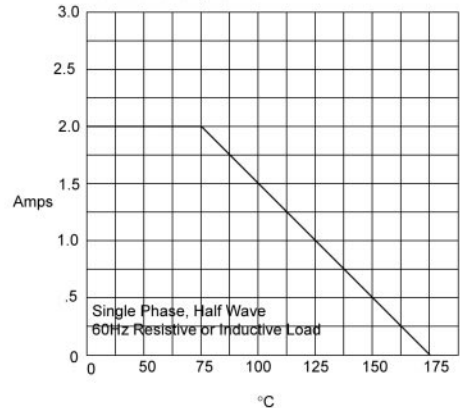

Typical Forward Characteristics



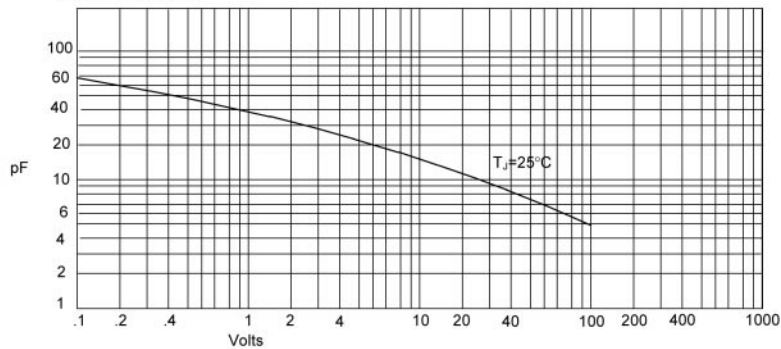
Instantaneous Forward Current - MicroAmperes *versus*

Ambient Temperature - °C

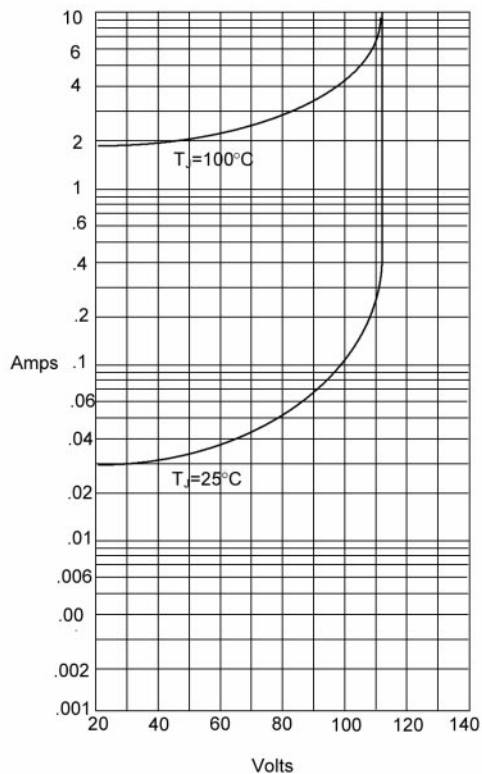

Reverse Voltage - Volts

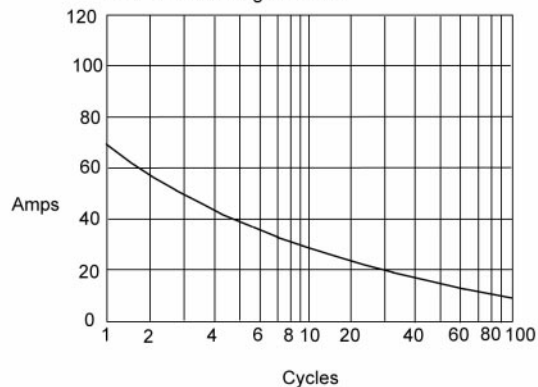
